#### Chinese New Year capacity reductions

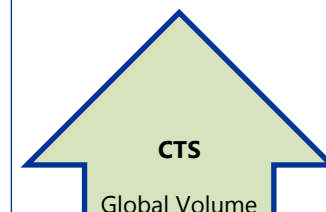
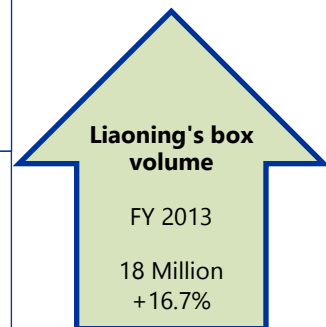
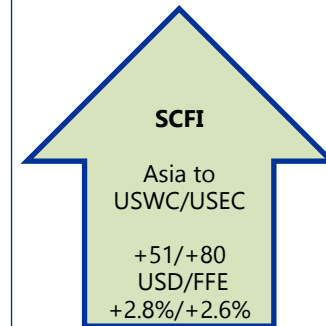
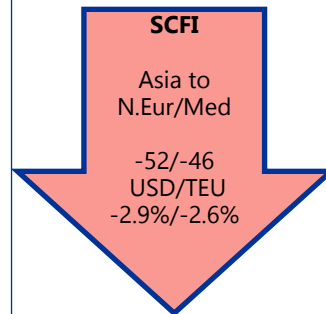
We take a closer look at the announced blank sailings on Asia-Europe, Transpacific and Asia-ECSA in connection with Chinese New Year, and the following capacity reductions, and find that they carriers need to blank significant more sailings if they want to reach the same relative capacity reductions as the last two years.
