### Executive Summary

#### Schedule Reliability in Brazilian Ports

Brazilian ports have through 2013 struggled to maintain an acceptable service level due to congestion issues and other incidents. The challenging year seems to have affected the carriers' schedule reliability significantly.

#### Rebound in 2016 in jeopardy

We analyse the state of the future supply/demand balance, and find that a rise in the order book reduces the chances for a structural rebound in the supply/demand balance in 2016.
