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Executive Summary

G6 Reliability on Asia-North Europe

We analyse G6 Asia-North Europe schedule reliability for each operating carrier, and find that APL and NYK have had a negative impact on the remaining G6 carriers' schedule reliability in the trade lane, as the two carriers have performed 10-15 percentage points below the G6 average.

Economic Impact of North American Ports

We take a closer look at the economic impact of the main US and Canada container ports, and find that 2.4% of the entire US working population have jobs supported by the ports, and 0.7% of the US economy is related to wages paid to employees working in or around the ports.

"Hidden" mega-vessel savings

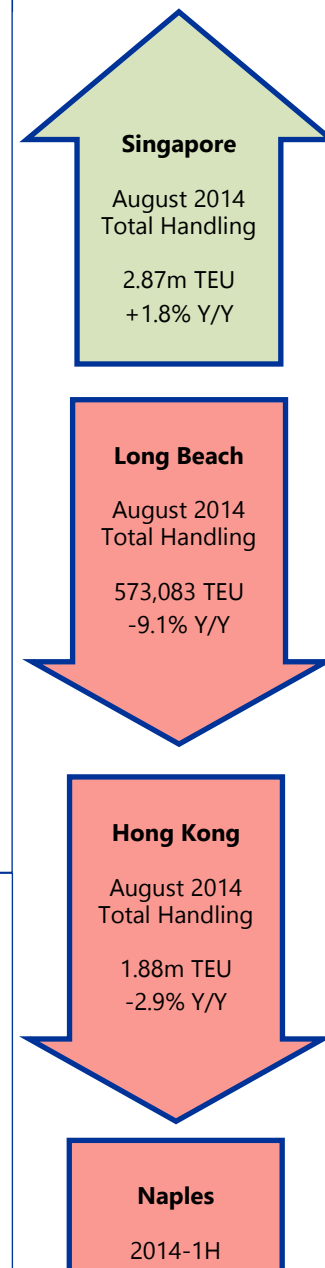
We analyse the port handling times for different vessels sizes, and find that larger vessels spend less time in port per TEU. This effect can be equivalent to a 15% unit fuel saving.
