Executive Summary

2014 Californian port throughput

In light of the heavy congestion that has hit the three main south-western US container ports of Oakland, Los Angeles and Long Beach, we take a closer look at the impact it has had on throughput in the ports. In spite of their problems the ports have grown 3.1% Y/Y in 2014, and Oakland has won a slightly higher share of inbound full TEU than in the previous years.

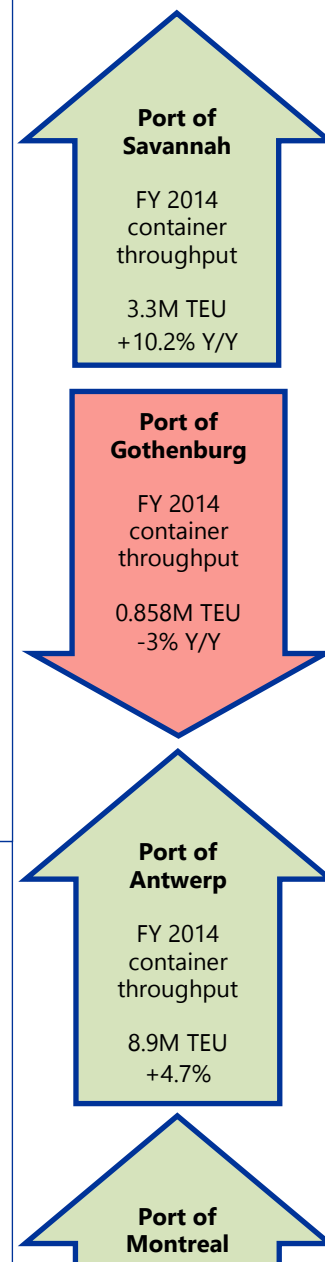
