

VALUE OF MARKET INTELLIGENCE

Focus on processes and not on systems

It is often stated that market intelligence is valuable. The question is how valuable is it? And how is that value obtained?

The fundamental question first: How does intelligence add value?

Basically, intelligence can add value in one of two ways: Either it is part of making (or changing) a decision, which would otherwise have been different without the presence of the intelligence, or the intelligence helps improve a negotiation position and thereby increases the value for either one – or both – of the parties involved in the negotiation.

What is then required for intelligence to add value in one, or both, of these ways?

Before digging further into this question, however, we need to ask a seemingly simple question: What is intelligence?

This can of course be defined in a multitude of ways, hence the definition we lay out here reflect how SeaIntel Maritime Analysis perceives it.

Intelligence is simply information pertaining to the market. This can be split
